[英文提要]

The essay attempts to provide a religious and ethical reflection on the human genome project. It imposes a question: Where shall wisdom be found regarding the human genome project? In answering the question, the author examines several contexts in which the project has been proposed and supported, egnetic reductionism, Baconianism, liberalism, eugenics, and capitalism, and demonstrates that they are leading the project in destructive directions to human welfare. As an antithesis, the author explores a Christian way to redirect the project, whereby the image God in his creation, and concern for the nutrition needs of the world and human beings must provide the fundamental guideline in directing the project.
