Gadamer and Theological Hermeneutics

[英文提要]

Gadamer is recognized as the foremost spokesman for philosophical hermeneutics. From the standpoint of aesthetics, reading theory, and even deconstructionism, hermeneutic theory was considered inherently anti-theology. However, in *Truth and Methodology*, Gadamer quoted freely from famous Christian theologians—from his mentor Bultmann, to Karl Barth, and Ebeling, pointing out that the liveliest discussions in contemporary hermeneutics were taking place in Protestant theology.

Therefore, whether we try to understand Christian theology from the perspective of hermeneutics, or vice versa, we do well to trace the relationship between Gadamer and theological hermeneutics. This article attempts to follow the hermeneutics of historical context, of historical theology, and the hermeneutics of game, in order to understand Gadamer's theory of the relationship between pietistic faith and understanding.
