Missionary Activities of Congrégation de La Mission in China

(Abstract) Congrégation de La Mission is one of five Catholic religious orders that came into China during the Ming and Qing Dynasties. Founded in Paris in 1625, the order devoted itself to reaching the poor who lived in the countryside and in the urban ghettos. Its missionaries arrived in China in large numbers in 1773. Between 1697 and 1935, they counted 946 members, including Chinese priests, and inherited the properties left by the Jesuits after they were disbanded. The missionaries of the Congrégation de La Mission played an important role in China's missionary history: they contributed to cultural exchange between East and West and the growth of Sinology.
