(Abstract) As a Protestant missionary, W. A. P. Martin was witness to the tumultuous history of China in the latter half of the 19th century where China and the West collaborated and collided over and over again. His missionary work grew slowly and was fraught with danger. Even into the 20th century, missionary life was not for the fainthearted. At times Christianity was embraced by indigenous Chinese culture. At other times it was exploited, resisted or ostracized by it. Now, in a new day of rapid globalization, cultural pluralism, and love for indigenous traditional heritage, Christianity is presented with new possibilities in both rural and urban China, a trend that should be observed and examined.
