[Abstract] The Student Volunteer Movement for Foreign Missions played a very important role in American missionary history. New theological concepts and convictions spurred a large-scale deployment of well-educated university students and professionals abroad for the missionary cause. China was a new field, and the high quality of missionaries was a new phenomenon. It transformed the missionary enterprise and provided personnel resources for the professionalization of American Sinology that had previously relied on the contribution of missionaries and diplomats.
