[Abstract] “Tao” is the foundation and core of the philosophical system of Lao Tzu, and “God” is the center of the Bible. Countless researchers and Bible scholars have studied the meaning of “Tao” and “God”. Some believe that the “Tao” of “Tao Te Ching” and the “God” of the Bible are essentially different expressions of the same concept. Others conclude that they are distinct and unique. In this article, the author attempts to compare the two by working from the original texts to allow the language of the texts to speak for themselves.
